REGULATORY NEWS

- FDA approved new drug for treatment of tuberculosis
- FDA okays blood plasma product for clotting disorders
- FDA approves transdermal patch for migraine

THE INTERESTING FACTS

- Cheap, widely available colchicine reduces cv events in secondary prevention
- Novel cancer hypothesis suggests antioxidants are harmful. Z. Chustecka
- High intakes of calcium in women are associated with higher death rates from all auses.
- Prevalence of ADHS growing at a frantic pace
- ADHS spread is increased in furious rate.

DRUGS SAFETY

- Everolimus 10 mg and pancreatic neuroendocrine tumors. Many adverse effects and uncertain benefit
- Venlafaxine and quetiapine bezoars keep in mind when symptoms of overdose persist
- Azithromycin - risk of potentially fatal heart rhythms.

EVIDENCE BASED MEDICINES

- Homeopathy: still no evidence of efficacy
- Furosemide in acute decompensated heart failure.

- Proton pump inhibitors and methotrexate
- Grapefruit and drug interactions
